Firstly, If you have not already done so, please register and pay your registration fee for the conference. There are also options for daily registrations (if you don't intend to attend the full meeting). You may register by selecting this link: [Registration page](#). **Please note that if you have not registered by Sunday the 22nd of January 2023, your poster presentation will be removed from the programme.**

Note that the signature has been updated to better correspond with the documents provided.

DESIGNING YOUR POSTER:

Your poster should be in **portrait format** and be legible when printed **A0 size**.

When designing your poster, please refer to the [#betterposter](#) movement as a means of designing your poster to get key messages to people in a short space of time and to improve the poster viewing experience.

Note: The YouTube video is 20 minutes long and contains a summary at the end should you be short on time. It also provides links to poster templates.

DISPLAYING YOUR POSTER:

Please print your poster and bring it with you to be displayed on a poster board in the exhibition hall (Hall 1 & 2 (Ground level)) for the duration of the poster session. SIZE: **A0 portrait**. We will provide double-sided tape to affix your poster to the board.

You will be able to put up your poster in the exhibition hall on the morning of your poster session and it should remain on display for the day*.

**Poster presentation slots will be confirmed closer to the time of the congress.*

Please also log in to the [abstract portal](#) and complete the following:

- i. Upload a head and shoulders photo as well as a contact bio (150 words) on the Contact Information page.

This will be displayed on the mobile app.

- ii. Upload a **PDF** copy of your poster on the Edit Abstracts tab.

This will be displayed on the mobile app.

Please have everything uploaded by 8 February 2023.

PRESENTING YOUR POSTER:

Poster sessions will take place on the 23rd, 24th and 25th of February 2023, as stated on the [congress programme](#). You will receive more information on the exact presentation time of your poster closer to the time of the congress.

*Note: As the programme is constantly changing, please check back regularly in case any changes have been made to your session. The programme will be updated on the website every **Monday**.*

During the poster session, presenters are encouraged to stand by their poster and engage with other delegates. Eligible presenters (students and young investigators, and travel fellowship holders) will have their posters assessed by a judge. Should you fall under the eligible categories mentioned above, you will be required to prepare a short 2-3 minute speech (just verbally and pointing to different sections of your poster) for the judges grading the posters.

Should a presenter be away from their poster, you will be able to send connection requests to other delegates to interact directly on the mobile app. Please check in on the mobile app regularly to see if you have received any queries.
